

City of Leoti Governing Body met in special session Wednesday, April 8, 2015, 12:00 p.m., at the City Hall Meeting Room in order to discuss and review a land use variance for Tyrrell Tankersley at 301 North 7th Street.

Mayor Cheryl Green and Councilors Amanda Baker, Tony Hernandez, Roger Porter, and Matt Price were present. Also in attendance were Tyrrell Tankersley, City Administrator Ted Cherry and Interim City Clerk Cindy Morcillo.

Mayor Green called the meeting to order at 12:00 p.m.

Baker moved, Price seconded, to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously.

Tyrrell Tankersley requested a land use variance to house up to seventy goats for the purpose of weed control at 301 North 7th Street. After careful consideration a determination was made that allowing seventy goats at a time was not in the best interest of the City.

Porter moved, Baker seconded, to approve the land use variance to Tyrrell Tankersley at 301 North 7th Street until November 2015 to house no more than fifteen goats at a time for the purpose of weed control. Mayor Green called the roll: Baker – Yea, Hernandez – Yea, Porter – Yea, Price – Nay. Motion carried.

Porter moved, Baker seconded, to adjourn at 12:15 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
