

City of Leoti Governing Body met in regular session Monday, April 16, 2018 at 7:00 p.m., at the City Hall Meeting Room.

Mayor Cheryl Green called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Mayor Green asked City Clerk Ashley Woods for Role Call; Councilors Kelma Burch, Jody Crouch, Levi Elder, Ken Farr and Charlie Hughes, City Attorney Becky Faurot, City Superintendent Juan Bocanegra and City Clerk Ashley Woods were present. Also in attendance were Travis Geyer, Everett Green and Courtney Berning.

Hughes moved, Burch seconded to approve the agenda. Motion denied unanimously. Crouch moved, Farr seconded to approve the agenda with the addition of item f Bindweed on North 2nd Street to Other Business. Motion carried unanimously.

Farr moved, Elder seconded to approve the consent agenda. Motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Green welcomed Travis Geyer of Associated Services who presented information about the City's plan and recommendations.

Mayor Green welcomed Everett Green of Rodenbeek Green Agency who presented recommendations about buildings not currently covered on the City's policy that should be, including storage tanks by the large water tower and water treatment plant and buildings and equipment at the park.

Council reviewed City Superintendent Bocanegra's written report. Council asked about weed spraying and gave go ahead for barbed wire by drainage ditch north of ball park to be removed and be replaced with smooth 2-wire fencing.

City Attorney Faurot stated her work was mostly in the agenda already.

Council reviewed City Clerk Woods' written. Crouch moved, Farr seconded for Woods to attend a grant workshop in Wichita May 13-15, 2018. Motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Green opened the floor to public comments. Courtney Berning asked for a status on the property north of her home; City Attorney Faurot informed her it was on the list for Sheriff's auction by the county.

Mayor Green opened the discussion on the insurance. Farr moved, Elder seconded to keep the policy with Associated Services. Motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Green opened the discussion on Summer Cinema. Item tabled to next agenda pending more information.

City Attorney Faurot presented the entity appropriation letter drafted per Council's request. Elder moved, Crouch seconded to approve the letter as written and mail it to the entity's stated April 24, 2018. Motion carried unanimously.

City Attorney Faurot presented different suggestions for the drug and alcohol policy changes; Council will review and discuss at the next meeting.

Mayor Green presented the current Purchasing Policy and asked that the Council review.

Mayor Green presented an idea for a possible new employee review form.

Crouch moved, Elder seconded to recess into executive session pursuant to the nonelected personnel matters exception, K.S.A. 75-4319(b)(1), to discuss a matter involving a city employee for 15 minutes with Council and Mayor. Motion carried unanimously. Meeting resumed at 8:57 p.m. Mayor Green declared no action taken.

Elder moved, Hughes seconded to recess into executive session pursuant to the nonelected personnel matters exception, K.S.A. 75-4319(b)(1), to discuss a matter involving a city employee for 15 minutes with Council and Mayor. Motion carried unanimously. Meeting resumed at 9:13 p.m. Mayor Green declared no action taken.

Crouch moved, Hughes seconded to recess into executive session pursuant to the nonelected personnel matters exception, K.S.A. 75-4319(b)(1), to discuss a matter involving a city employee for 10 minutes with Council and Mayor. Motion carried unanimously. Meeting resumed at 9:29 p.m. Mayor Green declared no action taken.

Hughes moved, Burch seconded for adjournment at 9:30 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
