

Draft Meeting Minutes

City of Leoti Governing Body met in regular session Monday, May 21, 2018 at 7:00 p.m., at the City Hall Meeting Room.

Mayor Cheryl Green called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Mayor Green asked Councilor Jody Crouch for Role Call; Councilors Jody Crouch, Levi Elder, Ken Farr, City Attorney Becky Faurot and City Superintendent Juan Bocanegra. Councilor Charlie Hughes, Kelma Burch and Interim City Clerk Cendy Morcillo were absent. Also in attendance were Courtney Berning, Diana Kirk, Lynda Goodrich, Clifford Blough, Travis Geyer and Simone Elder.

Farr moved, Levi seconded to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously.

Crouch moved, Elder seconded to approve the consent agenda. Motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Green welcomed Travis Geyer of Associated Services who presented information on a dividend check in the amount of \$7500.00 from EMC to the City.

Council reviewed City Superintendent Bocanegra's written report. Council asked about parking lines, mowers including parts for the Husqvarna, abatement of properties and bindweed. Council also asked about the bid from Tarbet for alley repair between 2nd & 3rd Street. Elder moved, Crouch seconded to approve the bid submitted by Tarbet Construction in the amount of \$5,000.00 to repair the alley between 2nd & 3rd Street. Motion carried unanimously.

City Attorney Faurot gave Council an update on the school zone signage, Carpenter easement and North 5th property.

Mayor Green opened the floor to public comments. Clifford Blough presented council with concerns in regards to protocol for new water service. Simone Elder went over the AIM Coalition draft of bike and pedestrian plan; there will be a reveal of the plan to the public sometime in July or August.

Mayor Green opened the discussion on the 2018 WC Park Board Appropriation. Elder moved, Farr seconded to issue the \$15,000 allocated for the 2018 WC Park Board appropriation. Motion carried unanimously.

Elder moved, Crouch seconded to recess into executive session pursuant to the nonelected personnel matters exception, K.S.A. 75-4319(b)(1), to discuss a matter involving a city employee for 5 minutes with Council, Mayor and City Attorney. Motion carried unanimously. Meeting resumed at 7:55 p.m. Mayor Green declared no action taken.

Farr moved, Crouch seconded to recess into executive session pursuant to the nonelected personnel matters exception, K.S.A. 75-4319(b)(1), to discuss a matter involving a city employee for 10 minutes with Council, Mayor and City Attorney. Motion carried unanimously. Meeting resumed at 8:12 p.m. Mayor Green declared no action taken.

Crouch moved, Elder seconded for adjournment at 8:15 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
