

City of Leoti Governing Body met in special session Monday, January 8, 2018 at 7:00 p.m., at the City Hall Meeting Room.

Mayor Green called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Mayor Cheryl Green, Councilors Amanda Baker, Levi Elder, Ken Farr, and Charlie Hughes, City Attorney Becky Faurot and City Clerk Ashley Woods were present. Also in attendance were Kelma Burch, Jody Crouch, Darren Crouch, Jadee Crouch, Shonda Taylor, Judge Janna DeLissa, and Simone Elder. Councilor Roger Porter was absent.

Baker moved, Farr seconded to approve the agenda with the addition of IV. - Appointment to Economic Development and moving Executive Session to V. Motion carried unanimously.

Hughes moved, Baker seconded to hire Juan Bocanegra as City Superintendent. Motion carried unanimously.

Newly elected Councilmembers Kelma Burch, Jody Crouch, and Levi Elder were sworn into office by Judge Janna DeLissa. Mayor Green presented former Councilor Amanda Baker with a Certificate of Recognition for Service.

Councilor Charlie Hughes was chosen as the new Council President.

Mayor Green asked for recommendations to fill the City's seat to Economic Development; discussion tabled to next meeting.

Hughes moved, Elder seconded to recess into executive session pursuant to the nonelected personnel matters exception, K.S.A. 75-4319(b)(1), to discuss a matter involving a city employee for 30 minutes with Council, Mayor and City Attorney. Motion carried unanimously. Meeting resumed at 7:42 p.m. Mayor Green declared no action taken.

Mayor Green asked for a motion to adjourn. Crouch moved, Farr seconded for adjournment at 7:43 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
