

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 28-127 OF THE LEOTI CITY MUNICIPAL CODE TO MAKE THE ALLEY RUNNING EAST-WEST THROUGH BLOCK FIFTEEN (15) OF THE ROANOKE ADDITION TO THE CITY OF LEOTI FROM GENESSE STREET TO WYOMING STREET A ONE-WAY TRAFFICED ALLEY.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Leoti wish to make address certain traffic issues related to the traffic flow before and after school to both ensure the safety and wellbeing of the public and protect the property interests of adjacent property owners.

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 8-2005 provides that Local authorities in their respective jurisdictions shall place and maintain such traffic-control devices upon highways under their jurisdiction as they may deem necessary to regulate or guide traffic.

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 8-2005 provides that all traffic-control devices erected shall conform to the state manual and specification

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the governing body of the City of Leoti, Kansas:

1. That Sections 28-127, of the Code of Ordinances, City of Leoti, Kansas, and shall be amended to read as follows:
Division 4: One-Way Streets
Section 28-127: Established
Indian Road from Highway 96 to H Street is designated as a one-way street, north-bound.
The alley running East-West through Block fifteen (15) of the Roanoke Addition to the City of Leoti from Wyoming Street to Genesse Street is designated as a one-way street, west-bound.
2. The signs placed shall confirm with the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices currently adopted by the State of Kansas.
3. The traffic regulation established in Section 28-127 shall not be effective until an official traffic control device giving notice of such traffic regulation is erected.
4. City Clerk will ensure the sign is recorded on the official city maps and the Sheriff is informed of the change. City Superintendent will ensure sign is ordered and placed in accordance with State law and regulations.
5. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its publication in the official City newspaper.
