

City of Leoti Governing Body met in regular session Tuesday, September 8, 2026 at 6:30 p.m., at the City Hall Meeting Room.

Mayor Chris Kreutzer called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Mayor Kreutzer asked Deputy City Clerk Patty Medina for Roll Call; Council President Derek Meyer, Councilors Kelma Burch, Aron White, Rick Griem and Jim Kreutzer. City Superintendent Blaine Medina, Aimee Baker and Susannah Louderbaugh were also present. City Attorney Charles Moser and City Clerk Jeannine Hassell were absent.

Mayor Kreutzer opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

White moved Meyer seconded to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously.

The Consent Agenda items included: a. August 24, 2026 Regular Meeting Minutes, b. Payroll warrants \$20,049.75, c. Accounts Payable warrants \$45,604.53, d. Accounts Payable warrants \$2963.40. (The warrants were available for review).

Meyer moved Kreutzer seconded to approve the consent agenda items A-D. Motion carried unanimously.

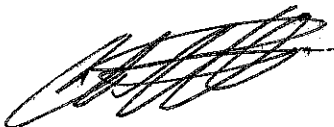
Mayor Kreutzer opened the floor to public comments. There were no comments.

J. Kreutzer moved Meyer seconded to approve grant writer agreement. Motion carried 3-2. Griem and White opposed.

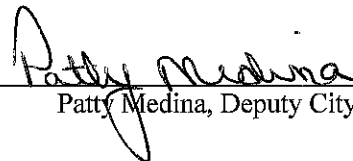
