

City of Leoti Governing Body met in regular session August 1, 2022 at 6:30 p.m., at the City Hall Meeting Room.

Mayor Charlie Hughes called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Mayor Hughes asked City Clerk Jeannine Hassell for Roll Call; Council President Greg Graff, Councilors Kelma Burch and Tammie Meyer-Givens. City Attorney Becky Faurot, Councilors Tyrrell Tankersley and Derek Meyer were absent. City Treasurer Liz Gould and Diana Minardi (Zoom) were present.

Mayor Hughes opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Burch moved Graff seconded to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously.

Givens moved Graff seconded to approve the consent agenda items A-D. Motion carried unanimously.

Council reviewed City Attorney Faurot's memo on Leoti Housing Authority, parking of trailers, Kansas Down payment Assistance Program and code sections being repealed in Ordinance 2022-05.

Diana Minardi, Kansas Down Payment Assistance Program was present via Zoom to answer any question council may have about the program.

Dina Minardi left the meeting at 6:40 pm.

Givens moved Burch seconded for the approval of the cooperation agreement with Sedgwick and Shawnee Counties, Kansas. Motion passed unanimously.

Graff moved Givens seconded for the approval of Resolution 2022-04 Cooperation Agreement. Motion passed unanimously.

Givens moved Burch seconded for the approval of ORDINANCE 2022-05 APPEALING APPENDIX A SECTIONS 508, 610, 902(4) AND 1104(5) AND ADDING APPENDIX A SECTION 1116 TO THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LEOTI CHANGING THE REGULATION OF TRAILERS AND RECREATIONAL VEHICLES PARKED ON PRIVATE LOTS. Motion passed unanimously.

Givens moved Burch seconded for the approval of Charter Ordinance 2022-01 A CHARTER ORDINANCE EXEMPTING THE CITY OF LEOTI, KANSAS FROM THE PROVISIONS OF K.S.A. 17-2341, AND PROVIDING SUBSTITUTE AND ADDITIONAL PROVISION ON THE SAME SUBJECT, PERTAINING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE HOUSING AUTHORITY BOARD OF THE LEOTI, KANSAS, AND ESTABLISHING THE MEMBERSHIP THERE OF. Motion passed unanimously.

Mayor Hughes opened the floor to public comments. There were no public comments.

City Treasurer Gould shared the CD Bids received from Western State Bank and Security State Bank. Council agreed to allow City Treasurer Gould to manage investments prioritizing the high bidder.

City Superintendent Seaton reported the crew has been busy prepping for fair. Council complimented the crew on how nice main street looked.

Code Enforcer Marcotte reported dog tags have been ordered for 2023, the municipal court date has been changed to August 10, 2022 this month.


Council reviewed City Clerk Hassell's written report. Hassell shared we have had a good response to the veterans banners. The order will be turned in at the end of the week.

Liz Gould and Adam Marcotte left the meeting at 7:03 pm.


