AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 12-108 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LEOTI DEFINING UNLAWFUL NUISANCES WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF LEOTI, KANSAS TO INCLUDE TIRES AND TUBES.

WHEREFORE, the City has a duty to protect the health and welfare of its citizens and protect neighborhoods from deterioration.

WHEREFORE, improperly storing or stacking unused tires poses certain health hazards, for example providing a breeding ground for mosquitoes and vermin.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the City of Leoti, Kansas:

1. Section 12-108(1) of the Municipal Code of the City of Leoti shall be amended to read as follows:

Sec. 12-108. Nuisances unlawful; defined.

It shall be unlawful for any person to maintain or permit any nuisance within the city as defined, without limitation, as follows:

- (1) Filth, excrement, lumber, rocks, dirt, cans, paper, trash, metal, tires, tire tubes, or any other offensive or disagreeable thing or substance thrown or left or deposited upon any street, avenue, alley, sidewalk, park, public or private enclosure or lot whether vacant or occupied
- 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its publication in the official City newspaper.
